



Director takes 'Challenge' to U.N.

LONDON -- Mark Terry's "The Antarctica Challenge: A Global Warning" will screen at the [United Nations Climate Change Conference](#).

Terry wrote, produced and directed the documentary via his Toronto-based Polar Cap Prods. It focuses on the threat to the polar regions and the mountain glaciers, highlighting new discoveries made in relation to the hole in the ozone layer, the diminishing populations of sea life and the increased world sea level.

Almost 190 world leaders and more than 11,000 participants are due to attend the confab, which takes place in Copenhagen Dec. 7-18. They aim to create the first climate-change policy applicable to all countries.
