WORLD TOUR 2010:

International Polar Year (2007 to 2009) was a call to the scientific community to study climate change in the world's polar regions. While much has been written about the social scientific research done in the Arctic, very little has surfaced from the physical scientific research done in Antarctica.

The Antarctica Challenge: A Global Warning is the only film made reporting these new discoveries. It was also the only film to be invited by the United Nations to screen at its Conference on Climate Change in Copenhagen December 7 to 18, 2009.

This unique HD documentary, made by Explorers Club member Mark Terry, is now available for special screenings to educational institutions, science conferences and environmental groups for its 2010 international tour. Included in this package is an appearance by filmmaker Mark Terry. For each screening, Mr. Terry will speak on his experiences in Antarctica, new advances in climate change research and his experiences as an official UN delegate helping draft the Copenhagen Accord.

The film has already secured national bookings with the International Polar Year Road Show and the Planet in Focus national tour in Canada. Elsewhere the film and Mr. Terry will be presenting in schools in New Brunswick, the University of Northern British Columbia, the University of Calgary, universities in Sao Paulo, Brazil and the IPY Science Conference in Oslo, Norway.
